

## Time Limits - Written and Oral Submissions

Practice Note No 1 of 2001

1. For the purposes of hearings by the Full Bench or by the President, the Full Bench or the President will give consideration in every case to whether time limits on oral submissions should be imposed. Time limits may only be exceeded with the leave of the Full Bench or the President given at the hearing.
2. For the purposes of hearings by the Full Bench or the President, each will give consideration in every case to imposing limits on the length of written submissions. Written submissions which exceed any such limit will only be considered by leave of the Full Bench or the President given at the hearing.
3. The parties (unless they appear in person or by a layperson and not by an industrial agent) shall file a written outline of submissions stating whether the party intends to present oral argument.
